The Czech Ice Hockey Association (CIHA) is a civic association that functions as the governing body of ice hockey in the Czech Republic. In 1908 it was one of the founding members of the International Ice Hockey Federation.

The CIHA organizes at the central level the men's 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> leagues, the extraliga and league for juniors, the extraliga and league for the U-19 category and the women's league.
